A=4.0, A-=3.7, B+=3.3, B=3.0, B-=2.7, C+=2.3, C=2.0, C-=1.7, D+= 1.3, D=1.0, D-=0.7, F=0.0. In order to calculate your major GPA; multiply the grade with the units you have completed for each class. After you total all the classes, divide that number into the total number of units. This number will be your major GPA.

For example if you received a B in PSY 200 and a B- in PSY 371 each class for 3 units), you multiply 3x3=9 for PSY 200 and 2.7x3 =8.1 for PSY 371.

Then Total 9+8.1=17.1 (total GPA) then divide 6 (total # of units) = 2.85 is your Major GPA.
