- ◆ This state-of-the-art graduate program offers specialized preparation for educators serving diverse learners on the autism spectrum.
- ◆ Because autism spectrum disorders (ASD) diagnosis is rising, it is likely that educators will serve students on the autism spectrum in their classrooms (including resource, special day, general education settings)
- ◆ Through specialized coursework and mentored field experiences, candidates will develop an understanding of the nature of ASD, become experts in supporting social and communicative competence, and learn to foster a high quality of life for individuals on the autism spectrum throughout the lifespan.
- ◆ Candidates earn a Level II (K-12) and/or Master's with an Autism Spectrum Certificate in a streamlined program without additional requirements
- ◆ Qualified candidates who are accepted into this program are eligible for a one-time **stipend** to offset tuition expenses.
