

Assembling Your Baggie Book

Materials Needed for Creating Baggie Books

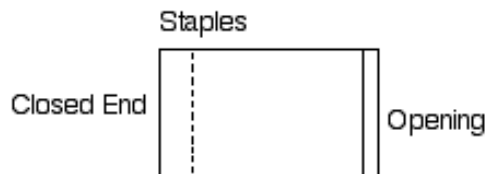
- 1 set Zip sealing type of plastic bags (2 ml thickness) 6x8 size
1 bag for every 2 book pages plus 1 bag for props
- 1 set Cardboard pieces per bag, cut a little smaller than bag size (5.5" x 6.75")
Colored cloth tape (Duct Tape) 1" width is best
Clear Polyethylene Repair Tape or other clear (non-yellowing) tape (optional)
Sticky back hook and loop fastener (Velcro)
Storybook pages and props pages
Clear contact paper
Sticky back foam for mounting your props

For this project you will need:

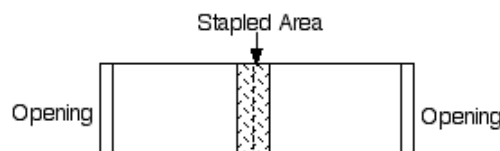
- 2 copies Story
(1 copy for the baggie book and 1 copy to cut out props)
- Zip sealing type of plastic bags (6x8)
- Cardboard,
- Colored cloth tape (Duct Tape), clear tape and clear contact paper
- Sticky back hook (male/rough) and loop (female/soft) fastener (Velcro)
- Scissors, colored markers, stapler w/ staples, ruler, permanent marker
- Sticky back foam

Directions

- Color and cut out 1 copy of the storybook pages (use outline as cutting guide).
- Color and cut out items (only) from second copy of the storybook pages, these will be the props for your baggie book.
- Cover the front and back of props with clear contact. You can mount the props on foam or another materials to make them thicker (easier to hold).
- Attach hook (male/rough) fastener to back of each prop.
- Take one bag and draw a line approximately 1" in from the closed end.
- Put the 18 bags together in a stack - closed ends together.
The bag with the line on it should be on top.

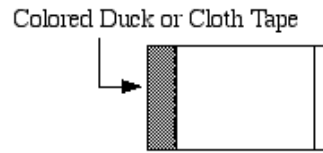


- Staple the 18 bags together at the closed end using the marker line as a guide for your staples. Place staples approximately 1/2" apart and 1/4" from ends of bag.
- Slide 1 piece of cardboard into each bag and put colored storybook pages into bags. (1 page in front of the cardboard, 1 page behind the cardboard)
The last bag will be a storage bag for the props.
- Open the baggie book, page by page (or bag by bag) and place a strip of clear tape between each plastic bag near the stapled area. Applying tape to this area will help to prevent the staples of the book from being pulled apart.



Assembling Your Baggie Book

- Place (wrap) a 2” strip of colored cloth tape over the front and back of the stapled area of the bags. This will form the “Binder” of your baggie book.



- Attach loop (female/smooth) fastener to the front of each book page so that the props can be attached.
